PRIME TIMBER, off a bit slowly, dueled outside NATIONAL SAINT, angled inside that one on the turn and gamely prevailed late following a stiff drive. NATIONAL SAINT sped to the early lead and dueled inside the winner while trying to get out on the backstretch, lugged out off the rail on the turn but continued gamely outside the winner to the wire. THE CHANGE was unhurried off the rail to the stretch and was along for third. FOLLOW WOODY outside HERUNSFORNOCKEY on the backstretch, angled in leaving the turn and weakened. BRACONNE, broke a bit slowly, settled off the inside, angled in for the turn, came out for the stretch and failed to menace. HERUNSFORNOCKEY stalked the pace off the inside, angled to the rail for the turn, gave way readily and was eased.
