EMPIRE HOUSE broke out a bit, sped to the early lead and angled in, set all the pace along the inside, kicked clear and held under some urging. DOHNSTER was in a good position stalking the pace inside throughout, could not match the winner but gamely edged a rival for second. CAPTAIN KALI squeezed a bit at the start, forced the pace outside the winner then stalked a bit off the rail, continued outside the runner-up leaving the turn and was edged by the latter for the place. OSCAR BOUND a bit slow to begin, chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. ANASTASIOS angled in and chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. MATCHING WHITES between horses early, angled in and settled inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and was not a threat. STAYONIT broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, was in a bit tight off heels in midstretch, angled out and did not rally. EXACTLY RIGHT stalked outside a rival, was between horses in midstretch and weakened.
