Footnotes

SKY VICTOR a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, came around a rival leaving the turn, angled out some in the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to wear down the runner-up in deep stretch. TRAIL MIX sped to the early lead, pulled under a rating hold while setting the pace a bit off the rail and held on well to deep stretch but could not quite match the winner late. MOBILIZED between horses early, chased inside, came off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and continued willingly to edge a rival for the show. EL MARTILLO chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out in the stretch and just missed third. JOURNEYMAN four wide early, was close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FIGEAC broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. CLEISTHENES pulled his way along to chase outside a rival, drifted out and dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
