HOT MARKET had good early speed three deep, set the pace off the rail, angled in some and inched clear on the turn, opened a commanding advantage in the stretch, was kept to urging past the sixteenth pole and was won under steady handling late. GREY MEMO bumped and a bit crowded after the start, was allowed to lag back a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and closed for the place. SPINELESSJELLYFISH had speed inside early then stalked along the rail, lacked the needed response in the stretch but held third. AFFAIRINTHEFOREST chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, swung four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. BONUS PAY DAY was in a good position stalking the winner three deep on the backstretch and turn, continued between horses in upper and midstretch and weakened. WAINGARTH had speed between horses then tracked the winner between foes to the stretch and also weakened.
