**Footnotes**

THE LEOPARD angled in and chased outside a rival, went up three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. INDIAN SUN stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was second best. MEER KAT (IRE) a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival, angled in on the backstretch, went around a foe into the stretch then rallied along the fence for the show. SPINNING SOUND (IRE) broke a bit slowly, chased outside a rival then three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and just missed third. ROBSCARVIC (IRE) chased inside then between foes on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. YES IT'S A CAT saved ground chasing the pace, split rivals leaving the second turn, bid inside in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. D. DOUBLE YOU pulled his way between horses early, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and outside a rival into the stretch and also weakened. MAKE THEM BREAK pulled three deep early, prompted the pace outside a rival, dueled between horses on the second turn, put a head in front leaving that turn and also weakened in the final furlong. GONE GRAND pulled his way to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fell back leaving the second turn and gave way in the stretch.
