Footnotes

FEISTY SUANCES sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, turned back a pair of bids from between horses in the stretch and proved best under a steady hand ride. ALL SAINT stalked the pace outside a rival then three deep into the turn, bid three wide into the stretch and until just past midstretch, then could not quite match the winner but held second. MENSA HEAT a half step slow to begin, chased just off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, bid along the fence in the stretch and just held third. DANNY Q bobbled slightly at the start, settled off the rail, went outside a rival into the stretch, came out some in the drive and was edged for the show. AQUICKSTING broke in a bit, pulled his way up to stalk the winner inside then just off the rail, was between horses leaving the backstretch, dropped back outside a rival on the turn, angled back in nearing the stretch and weakened.
