Footnotes

FANTASTIC FILLY (FR) unhurried a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch, rallied to a clear lead while drifting in and out past midstretch, then ducked out sharply and was steadied in late stretch but held. SMART TIMING washy at the gate, saved ground, moved up inside into the second turn, steadied past the three eighths pole, came out a bit in upper stretch and picked up the place. EMINENT sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn, could not match the winner, was narrowly edged for second and just held third. SKATESHEBA (FR) off a bit slowly, saved ground unhurried, waited for room leaving the second turn, advanced inside in the stretch and just missed the show outside the pacesetter. LUCIEN four wide early, angled in on the first turn, steadied in tight leaving that bend, split rivals with a move forward on the second turn, appeared a threat in midstretch but was outfinished. LANGOUREUSE broke slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and seven wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. SKYWRITING settled outside, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WORD PUZZLE pulled early and steadied in tight into the first turn, chased outside on the backstretch and four wide on the second turn and weakened. SHEZA NINER five wide into the first turn, chased outside, dropped back on the backstretch, lacked room off heels into the stretch and to midstretch and could not offer the needed response. PREMIERE EVENT pulled her way along outside early and stalked the pace outside a

rival on the first turn then off the inside on the backstretch, continued outside a foe leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. EURO EMPIRE stalked inside early, lugged out on the backstretch, dropped back between foes on the second turn, angled in for the stretch and weakened, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off.
