EL CIELO unhurried off the rail early, angled in on the turn and moved up inside, swung out three deep into the stretch and closed gamely outside under urging to get up late. TEXAS GLITTER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, inched clear on the turn, remained clear past midstretch and just failed to hold off the winner. FULL MOON MADNESS saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and finished gamely between foes late. PURELY COZZENE went up between rivals on the backstretch to chase the leader, was in tight off heels early on the turn, continued outside the winner on the bend and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. TREASURE HUNT stalked the leader a bit off the rail on the backstretch and between foes nearing the turn, continued outside a rival on the bend and three deep into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. SHOW ME THE STAGE close up outside early and four wide a half mile out, dropped back approaching the turn, angled in some on the bend and weakened. FIVE STAR DAY off a trifle slowly, went up between horses early and stalked off the rail, dropped back three deep early on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and gave way.
