ROLLY POLLY (IRE) chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied to the front past midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. TWIN SET (GER) settled outside a rival on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the place. SALTLY HELEN sped to the early lead then dueled outside a rival, put a head in front into the stretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch then settled for the show. DUSTY HEATHER unhurried outside on the backstretch and turn, came out a bit into the stretch and improved position. FAIR APACHE stalked the dueling leaders a bit off the rail to the stretch and weakened. SEA OF ICE angled in and settled a bit off the rail and lacked the needed response. SISSI SONG (FR) also angled in some and raced unhurried a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. CAJUN FLASH went up inside to duel on a short lead inside on the backstretch and turn but weakened in the stretch.
