Footnotes

BADIO STATION bobbled at the start, angled in and settled a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging in the final furlong to gain the lead nearing the wire and gamely prevailed. PUSH OVER broke a bit slowly, went three deep into the first turn, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch, bid between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly. FAMILIAR SHINE pulled his way along to duel outside a rival then between foes on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, fought back just off the rail until deep stretch and held third. BROTHER LOUIE chased a bit off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch, bid between foes and steadied in tight in midstretch and was outfinished toward the inside. MR. COLLEN bumped at the start, stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, battled outside in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. ONE LUCKY GUY allowed to settle outside or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SCREWBALL sent along inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the second turn, fell back some in midstretch and weakened. STARRY STRIVE chased between horses then outside a rival to the stretch and did not rally. SUITCASE SIMPSON broke out and bumped a rival, chased inside,

came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WARRENS TEMPTATION pulled his way along and steadied off heels into the backstretch, stalked just off the rail then between foes, continued a bit off the fence on the second turn and weakened in the drive.
