Footnotes

ALL THE GEARS off a bit slowly, pulled outside a rival early, moved up four wide on the backstretch, took command outside the early leader nearing the second turn, kicked clear in hand, opened up under a brisk hand ride then was taken under a hold late. KUDOS vied for the lead between foes early and drifted out a bit into the first turn, angled in on the backstretch and chased the leader, came out into the stretch and got the place late. QUALITYNOTQUANTITY dueled three deep early then stalked outside the runner-up, continued a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn and just held third. CROWN DERBY saved ground off the early pace, split horses leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. DYNA KING also saved ground early, was taken out from the inside leaving the first turn, split horses on the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and weakened. TEXAS SANDMAN was climbing some while pulling his way to the early lead, dueled inside, kicked clear into the backstretch, offered little resistance inside the winner into the second turn and weakened.
