**Footnotes**

STORM MATE dropped back off the rail after an alert beginning, angled in and moved up leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and rallied under brisk hand urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and pulled clear. DOPPIO off a bit slowly, moved up inside on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and was second best. ORBITS WORLD chased outside then alongside a rival into and on the turn, lacked room behind foes into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and just got the show. MR. SPLASH had good early speed and duelled inside, inched away in the stretch and weakened some late but just lost third. HEDGE YOUR BET angled in and duelled outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. TERRITORIAL settled inside, moved up along the rail on the turn but lacked the needed rally. YES HE'S A PISTOL chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, was a bit crowded behind the winner nearing midstretch and weakened. SIETE DE LA SUERTE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out in the

lane and passed tiring rivals. HIGH STYLE GENT chased outside and four wide on the turn and weakened. RADIO STATION MAN four wide early, stalked three deep then off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SUREFIRE SUCCESS had speed between foes then stalked between rivals and three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn, dropped back on the bend and had little left for the stretch.
