BIGBARI stalked outside, bid three deep on the turn, took the lead leaving the bend, inched away and angled in, drifted out under left handed urging late

and held gamely. CRESTATORRE between horses early, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch and finished willingly. ONEBADBOY hopped at the start, pulled his way along outside stalking the pace, went three deep on the turn, angled in some into the stretch and also continued willingly. SEEK THE LIGHT chased outside a rival then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, drifted in late and clearly bested the others. WARREN'S DA MAN settled outside then alongside a rival, went three wide on the turn and into the stretch and improved position. MR. KINGOFTHE ROAD stalked a bit off the rail then inside to the stretch and weakened. QUIETLY WAITING broke a bit awkwardly, settled outside a rival to the stretch and did not rally. JUST JUMPED IN saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a threat. NONREFUNDABLE pulled his way along between horses then chased off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. STEEL TRICK a bit slow into stride, settled inside then outside a rival, angled back in on the turn and failed to menace. LINCECUM had speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, steadied between horses nearing the quarter pole and weakened. ARGYLL LAD went up inside to duel for the lead, stalked leaving the turn, was between foes into the stretch and also weakened.
