PACIFIC OCEAN had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging. IRREFUTABLE chased inside then a bit off the rail, went around a rival into the stretch and finished well along the fence, then tied up and collapsed after being unsaddled and was vanned off. M ONE RIFLE had speed four wide then stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and split horses late for the show. EUROEARS sent between foes early, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award. QUIET INVADER dueled outside the winner then stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch, was not a match for the that one in the drive and weakened late to be outfinished for a minor share. CARBONITE chased off the rail then angled in midway on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. CANONIZE squeezed when bumped at the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. SHEDIK (FR) also steadied when bumped at the start, settled outside then off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. COMMA TO THE TOP broke in onto rivals, had speed between foes then stalked off the rail, angled in some for the turn, came out into the stretch, was between horses again in midstretch and weakened.
