KATY'S KITTY stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses in tight quarters on the second turn, took the lead three deep into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and proved best under urging. CHARM THE CROWD angled in on the first turn, chased outside a rival, bid four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, was three deep nearing midstretch and was second best. REAL ROCKPORT five wide early, angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, bid along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and clearly bested the others. DUBAI PERFECTO bumped at the start, sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, battled between foes leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. ROYAL CHAVELA four wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival, found the rail into the second turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SHESKEY bumped at the start, prompted the pace outside a rival, was between horses on the second turn, dropped back just past midway on that bend, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive. PHI BETA HEAT threw her head a bit and was squeezed back at the start, saved ground throughout and lacked a response in the stretch.
