STONEY FLEECE angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn, swung out into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. HANDSOME MIKE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. BATTLE FORCE a step slow to begin, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled out into the stretch and finished with interest. MOTOWN MEN had speed between foes then dueled outside the runner-up to the stretch and weakened. DEVIL IN DISGUISE unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and improved position. BLUE WHITE FIRE (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled inside, went between horses leaving the backstretch and outside a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAJOR MAGIC angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GOT EVEN three deep early, stalked the dueling leaders off the rail, angled in some leaving the second turn and weakened. SENOR RAIN three deep early, bore out badly on the first turn and was pulled up.
