Footnotes

INCURABLE OPTIMIST, saved ground, moved up leaving the backstretch, took command on the second turn, then drew clear under urging. COMPANY APPROVAL, settled off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and just got second. BRAVE GUN, three deep early and four wide early on the backstretch, angled in midway on the backstretch, moved up inside on the second turn, came out for the stretch and just lost the place. CARTEL sped to the early lead, set the pace under a hold while trying to get out between rivals, lugged out on the second turn and weakened. MR. STEVE broke a bit awkwardly and slowly, settled off the rail and improved position in the stretch. DAWN FLIES BY, four wide early, angled in on the backstretch, split rivals in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRILLIANTLY forced the early pace inside, prompted the issue between rivals on the backstretch, found the inside again on the second turn and weakened. ACTIN TIME bobbled several times while pulling under a hold inside nearing the first turn, went four wide to prompt the pace on the backstretch, drifted out on the second turn and gave way.
