**Footnotes**

SECURITIZED DEBT, sped to the early lead, angled in a bit off the rail, led throughout and drew off without encouragement. LITTLE BALLERINA, angled in early, had a rail trip and picked up the place late. MELANCHOLY BABY, stalked the early pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the turn, was no match for the winner and lost second late. MAI TAI PAN, broke inward and a bit awkwardly, stalked outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the turn and weakened. BE A CLOWN, off a bit slowly, was taken outside a foe on the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn and did not rally. STRIDING SPIRIT, was sent along early, chased off the rail, was outside a rival on the turn and gave way.
