DONA AMELIA (CHI) broke inward, stalked the pace inside, waited briefly midway on the turn, came out in upper stretch, rallied to the front under urging three deep past the sixteenth pole and proved best. QUICKLY GONE had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside a rival on the turn, fought back between foes past midstretch then inside the winner and was clearly second best. CARBELLA had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside, also fought back in midstretch, weakened some late but bested the others. CATCH CANDY chased outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. ROCKIN ROSE close up stalking the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued off the rail in the stretch and lacked a further response. STARSTRUCK KRISTEN broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in some leaving the backstretch and again in the stretch and failed to menace. DIXIE HAWKS prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened.
