Footnotes

VERGENNES stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside DIXIE DOT COM on the second turn, took the lead in upper stretch and pulled clear under urging. DIXIE DOT COM sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back when challenged and continued willingly to the wire. LONE BID (FR) broke a bit slowly, raced between rivals early, moved up three deep on the second turn, then just got the show. LADIES DIN broke flat-footed, settled outside, went four wide leaving the backstretch and three deep on the second turn to loom a threat but lacked the needed late response. DR FONG broke a bit slowly, saved ground, waited briefly off heels early on the second turn, came out three deep to split rivals leaving that turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary late bid. MAIL COACH (CHI) broke slowly, saved ground and improved position. LIDO (IRE) came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went four wide with a bid on the second turn but could not sustain his bid. CROWD PLEASER settled a bit off the rail, went between rivals leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, then weakened. PREVALENCE (GB) angled in early and saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened. TAKARIAN (IRE) angled in early, went between horses on the backstretch, continued outside and dropped back on the second turn and had nothing left for the stretch.
