Footnotes

CHALULA ONE chased a bit off the rail then inside and rallied along the fence under urging to prove best. CHOBE CHIKA had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch and just held second between horses. YODELADY O prompted the pace between horses then stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, re-bid between foes in the stretchy and held third. IMFOREAL forced the pace three deep then between horses, stalked between foes on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, re-bid outside rivals in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. MOONLIGHT TIZZY stalked outside then bid four wide a half mile out, tracked the leader outside foes on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. RUFFLED FEATHERS dropped back off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out in upper stretch and was not a threat. CATIFORNIA DREAMIN broke a bit slowly, settled three deep then outside a rival, came out in the stretch and did not rally. BELLA BUBBLES also a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace to the stretch and lacked the needed response. GREY BABE also broke a bit slowly, pulled early, settled off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and was not a factor.
