**Footnotes**

T. D. VANCE pulled his way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail then inside, awaited room leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, rallied between rivals and was bumped in late stretch but got up between horses under urging. STONESIDE (IRE) stalked inside, bid alongside a rival on the turn, gained the lead in the stretch, inched away, drifted out under left handed urging in deep stretch, bumped a rival when between horses late and continued willingly to the wire. GET FUNKY stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, continued outside past midstretch, was bumped in late stretch and also went on willingly four wide on the line. QUIETLY MINE dropped back between foes then chased outside a rival on the backstretch and between foes on the turn, split horses twice in the stretch and finished with interest inside. CHEROKEE HEAVEN settled outside, went three deep on the backstretch and turn, came out five wide into the stretch and continued on well to the end outside foes. TIZ WEST stalked between foes on the backstretch and most of the turn, came three deep into the stretch, was forced out a bit in late stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BANNER LODGE was in a good position chasing the pace outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CANDY PULL sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the turn, fought back inside in the stretch and weakened late. CHHAYA DANCE pulled his way along the inside on the backstretch, stalked inside on the turn, continued on the rail in the stretch and did not rally. Following a stewards' inquiry, STONESIDE was disqualified and placed third

for interference in late stretch.
