EX MISS FUZZ quickly sped to the lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail and won clear under a long hold. DANCING FOR BOUNTY off a half step slowly, went up between horses early, stalked along the inside, came out into the stretch and held second. OUR HERE TIZ between horses early, raced unhurried a bit off the rail to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and bested the others. DREAMY MEETING sent along inside to chase the winner, came a bit off the rail on the turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked a late response. R FAR OUT STAR settled outside on the backstretch and turn, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. OUR LADY T close up stalking the pace three deep early then outside the runner-up, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. VALDASTAR unhurried outside early, continued off the rail on the turn, angled in nearing the stretch, found the rail in the stretchy and did not rally.
