Footnotes

STOCKS ARE RISING forced the pace between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, gained the advantage leaving the bend, inched away into the stretch and held under urging. HERE ME OUT stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, loomed a threat behind the winner past midstretch then just held second. NICK (CHI) broke slowly, trailed a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn, moved up inside into the stretch, came out in midstretch and again in late stretch and finished well. PARA ALQUILAR climbing a bit early, came out off the inside on the backstretch, went four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SLEW STEW settled outside then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and also could not offer the necessary response. MECKEME had good early speed and pressed the pace three deep, stalked off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ITALIAN SUNSET sped to the early lead, dueled inside on the backstretch and turn and also weakened in the drive.
