**Footnotes**

JOHAR steadied when squeezed after the start, settled off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to prove best. MANANAN MCLIR chased inside early then between horses leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals late and just held second. ROYAL GEM chased outside a rival then between horses, continued between foes on the second turn, came out for the stretch and just missed the place. ROCK OPERA stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, took a short lead on the second turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch, inched away in midstretch but was overtaken. INESPERADO (FR) forced in early, chased outside, went four wide on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed response. UNION PLACE angled in after the start, stalked off the rail, bid between horses leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, continued inside into the stretch and weakened. SURPRIZED was in a good position chasing outside then three deep on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened. CENTURY CITY (IRE) off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, inched forward leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MUSIC'S STORM pulled his way up inside to the lead, set the pace along the rail, dueled into and on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left.
