MARQUET REBEL pulled his way along on the rail around the first turn, continued to stalk on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, swung out around the dueling leaders at the top of the lane and drew out in the final furlong. DYNAMIC HOST trailed the field down the backstretch while off the rail, was three deep on the second turn, came into the stretch four wide and rallied for the place while no real threat to the winner. DONTMESROUNDWITJIM chased three deep down the backstretch, remained off the rail around the second turn, entered the lane three wide, angled to the middle of the track in the late stages and was up for the show. FOREST PRINCE stalked the pacesetter around the first turn, moved up entering the backstretch to reach even terms with MILTY WAY, dueled outside that rival to the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong. MILTY WAY sped to the lead into the first turn, was challenged for command on the backstretch by FOREST PRINCE, dueled inside that foe to the top of the stretch and weakened on the inside through the final furlong.
