BROKEN DREAMS had speed inside then stalked along the rail, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter in the drive, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and drew clear under a brisk hand ride. SOFTLY SINGING bobbled at the start, chased inside then a bit off the rail, moved up along the fence leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and just got the place three deep on the line. OUI SAY OUI (IRE) also bobbled at the start, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and was edged for second between horses late. FOLK DANCER had speed outside the winner then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong and was edged late for a minor award. APPEALING AFARE stalked outside a rival then off the rail, continued alongside the runner-up leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
