Footnotes

DAYTIME (GB) came off the rail leaving the first turn, moved up three deep into and on the second turn, gained the lead just past midstretch, inched clear and held under urging. LIDO (IRE), squeezed a bit at the start, angled in, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, waited a bit off heels leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals and finished well. P. T. INDY, settled outside a foe, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied willingly. GEN STORMIN'NORMAN also settled outside a rival, dropped back three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. Z. SHEIKH saved ground well placed to the stretch and lacked the necessary late response. PROSPECTHEUS, saved ground unhurried to the stretch, came out and improved position. KING CRIMSON, angled in and dueled inside to the stretch and weakened. CHATTING, balked at the gate, was rank under a hold early then taken back, bid three deep into the second turn and outside a rival into the stretch, took a short lead but weakened in the final furlong. ONE MAN ARMY, drifted out into the first turn, dueled outside KING CRIMSON, dropped back between foes on the second turn and had little left. VIALE (URU) pulled inside early, saved ground, came out leaving the second turn and failed to menace.
