THERESA'S TIZZY broke a bit in the air but recovered quickly and sprinted to the front, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and into the turn, battled gamely between horses leaving the turn and to midstretch, regained a short lead, drifted in a bit in deep stretch but inched away late. HOOKEDONTHEFEELIN went up inside the winner to duel for command, put a head in front on the turn, fought back inside into and through the stretch, steadied a bit in deep stretch, could not match the winner late and just held second. SQUALL CITY stalked the pace off the rail or three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, bid three across leaving the turn, dueled, also could not match the winner late and just missed the place. QUEEN OF WILSHIRE allowed to settle off the inside, continued outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. GROOMS DERBY pulled her way between foes on the backstretch then stalked a bit off the rail, was shuffled back a bit into the turn, found the rail and weakened.
