RESIDENT ALIEN had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear in the stretch and proved best under urging. ACLEVERSHADEOFJADE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, angled in some on the turn, came out three deep into the stretch and gained the place. INDIAN FLARE dueled three deep then outside the winner, could not match that one in the stretch, lost second late and just held third. VIKKI'S HONOR stalked off the rail then outside, split horses on the turn, angled in nearing the stretch and just missed the show inside. HICKORY (CHI) off a bit slowly, settled inside, remained toward the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAEMY (BRZ) angled in on the backstretch and saved ground chasing the pace and could not summon the necessary response. SUMMER BAY had speed between foes then stalked off the rail then three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and gave way.
