**Footnotes**

YANKEE DAN sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set all the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and just held under urging. TRUCIAL STATE fanned out into the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival, went four wide into the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied to just miss three deep on the line. TEANCUM stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch and went willingly between foes late. FLYING MARINE steadied between horses into the first turn, angled in and chased just off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, drifted to the inside in the drive and lacked the needed rally. SABE angled in and stalked outside a rival then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. WILLIAM WALLACE drifted out some into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MCALLISTER BOYS four wide into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. VICTORIASUGRDADDY saved ground chasing the pace, came out between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SILVERADO CANYON kept five wide into the first turn, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside on the second turn and in the

stretch and did not rally. NEMRAC broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WARREN'S WASCO SON fanned six wide into the first turn, angled in and settled just off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace.
