TAXI RIDE sped between horses to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, inched away on the backstretch, kicked clear leaving the second turn and into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. MELTARIB stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and finished willingly three wide on the wire. SUNBURN chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn, came out in midstretch, split foes a sixteenth out and again at the wire in a game try. EVASIVE CHARMER pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, came out a bit in upper stretch then lacked the needed late kick along the fence. QUIET ADVICE angled in on the first turn and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and in the stretch and did not rally. CALIFORNIA HEAT broke in a bit, saved ground when unhurried to the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MO CHEESE prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked just off the rail, dropped back between foes leaving the second turn and weakened.
