FIVE A DAY sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then inside on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and drew clear under a tap of the whip and a brisk hand ride, then a long hold late. BREAKMARK stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the turn and in the stretch and was clearly second best. SWONGS saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the turn, came off the rail past midstretch and picked up the show. JESSE'S SOUL stalked three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. WISEST CAT chased off the inside, split horses on the turn, continued off the fence into the stretch and did not rally. SOPHOMORIC VENTURE settled just off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch, continued toward the inside on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. MR. NIGHT RIDER between foes early, settled off the rail then angled in on the turn and failed to menace. GOLDEN AUGUSTO broke in a bit, settled three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and was not a threat. PADRE JON broke out a bit, settled outside then three wide on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BEAU CHEVAL stalked between horses then dropped back inside on the turn and gave way.
