FARLEY STAR (GB) was unhurried while chasing the pace off the rail down the backstretch, angled over to save ground around the second turn, swung outside to the middle of the course at the top of the lane and ran past all her rivals to prove best. JEOPARDY LADY chased off the rail around the first turn and outside a foe down the backstretch, split horses leaving the furlong marker and gained the place. PICTURE PERFECT (IRE) sped to the lead on the inside into the first turn, battled back on the inside in the final furlong and lost the place in the late stages. FAST EYDIE stalked the pacesetter on the outside down the backstretch, came into the stretch between horses, also went willingly to the wire and was edged for the show at the wire. HAMEILDAEME (GB) chased the pace off the rail down the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide and failed to mount a bid in the final furlong. PRECIOUS UNION pulled a bit and steadied on the inside entering the first turn, chased inside a foe down the backstretch, remained on the inside and weakened in the final furlong.
