### Footnotes

SPECIAL MATTER saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter in the drive, took a short lead past midstretch, inched away under some urging and held on gamely. NIGHT BOKBEL (IRE) broke slowly, settled inside, went between horses into and on the second turn, came out for room in the stretch and closed willingly. CONTINENTAL RED saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into and through the stretch and also went on gamely to the end. SWEET STEPPER sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back inside the winner but was outfinished. SIGINT was in a good position chasing the pace between foes then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, continued between horses leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. TRIAL BY JURY stalked the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SILVER TRAFFIC bumped between horses at the start, pulled early and steadied off heels approaching the first turn, chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back on that bend, angled in nearing the stretch and lacked a further response. VASYWAIT (FR) off a bit slowly, chased three deep, came four wide into the stretch, then drifted in and weakened.
