PROUD TOWER TOO sped to the early lead and dueled inside rivals but a bit off the rail, angled in and inched away on the turn, came just off the fence into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. JACK'S WILD broke a bit slowly, settled just off the inside, came out three deep into the stretch and closed gamely. AREYOUTALKINTOME dueled between horses then outside the winner, stalked that one on the turn and into the stretch and continued willingly but was outfinished. TEXCESS chased outside a rival then pulled his way up inside leaving the backstretch, stalked along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. QUITEN BOY unhurried off the rail early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and made up some ground but was not a threat. STALKING TIGER chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and gave way. UNCLE DENNY stalked early then prompted the pace three deep, tracked the winner outside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
