Footnotes

INCLUDING WARDO chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead three wide in midstretch, kicked clear under left handed urging and held. UNEX DALI (GB) broke slowly, angled in and settled inside, went around a rival on the second turn, regained the rail into the stretch, came out nearing midstretch and closed willingly to just miss. POPULAR CAUSE sped to the early lead, kicked clear, opened a commanding advantage on the backstretch, continued clear on the second turn, fought back some in midstretch and weakened but just held third. PARABLE off a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch and split foes on the wire to narrowly miss the show. RENEWING angled in and chased inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, bid between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. T. K. FORTYSIX settled outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award four wide on the line. QUAIL HILL stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out off the fence for room in midstretch and weakened while between foes on the wire.
