AGGIE ENGINEER took the early lead a bit off the rail then angled in and set a moderate pace under a rating hold along the inside, kicked clear in the stretch and held gamely under urging. SPURRIER three deep early, was forced four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some late and outfinished rivals for the place. SOUL CANDY settled inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and got up for third late. DAKOTA PHONE came out three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, angled out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. ACHAK (IRE) pulled early, stalked outside a rival then inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ROMP (ARG) rank inside early, came out into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. PHILATELIST stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened.
