SEA OF DESIRE had good early speed and dueled between horses, took a short lead in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. HERE COMES BONNIE angled in and forced the pace four wide then three deep on the turn and through the stretch and went willingly to the wire. MIL ESTRELLAS sent between horses early, dueled a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn, fought back in the stretch and continued gamely to the end. CAL BAYERS dropped back between horses then settled outside, angled to the inside on the turn, came out in the stretch and closed willingly late. NEVER SHEA NEVER

broke a bit slowly and was squeezed back, moved up between horses then chased off the rail, angled in on the turn, split rivals in midstretch and finished with interest. TERRELLA chased off the rail then three deep into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BULLETGIRL had good early speed and stalked between horses then outside a rival on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ELECTRIC EMILY broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail chasing the pace and could not offer the necessary response. NIFTY DREAM settled outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. GAMBLING COWGIRL bobbed at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. SIGMA BONDED a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came off the rail on the turn, angled out in the stretch and was not a threat. LA CHILENA angled in and dueled between horses three deep, dropped back outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gave way.
