FIVE STAR DAY, quickly sped to a clear lead, set the pace inside and held on gamely under urging. YOUR HALO, went up to chase the winner between horses to the stretch and closed willingly late. SON OF A PISTOL, tracked the winner four wide on the backstretch, ranged up three deep leaving the turn, lugged in a bit in midstretch but also finished well. EARLY PIONEER, three deep between horses on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, then came back on late. QUAKE, chased along the inside to the stretch, came out and weakened.
