BELLE OF HUMBOLDT, sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside and held on gamely under urging. SHOE CRAZY, stalked three deep early and outside on the backstretch, continued three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. FAIR KATE, angled in on the first turn and saved ground tracking the winner, came out into the stretch and finished with interest. ALI KATE, had a rail trip chasing the winner and also went on willingly late. BIMBO'S KISS, pulled a bit early, settled off the rail, went between horses into and on the second turn, steadied when blocked leaving that bend, came out four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid. MUSCHI, settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, remained inside and had a mild bid. STEWARDI CAN, saved ground on the first turn, came out a bit on the backstretch, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PRIZED BUY, angled in unhurried approaching the first turn, swung out into the stretch and failed to menace. GRISELLE, between rivals close up on the first turn, continued outside, went three deep on the second turn and weakened. SPRING TO SUMMER, stalked three deep early then outside FAIR KATE, was between foes on the second turn and also weakened.
