RIVIERA COCKTAIL settled outside a rival into the first turn then along the inside, cut the corner into the stretch, bid inside in midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. PLEASURE TO RIDE stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, put a head in front three deep in midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. FEISTY SUANCES pulled his way along three deep then stalked just off the rail, bid three wide between foes into the stretch, battled between horses through the final furlong and continued on well to the end. GOLDEN MEXICO (IRE) chased just off the inside, swung out into the stretch and found his best stride late four wide on the wire. GRETSKY angled in and settled a bit off the rail then inside, swung out into the stretch and finished with interest outside foes late. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, opened up on the backstretch, drifted out into and through the stretch and weakened in the drive.
