RACHEL JONES stalked the pace off the rail to the stretch and wore down the runner-up under left handed urging in deep stretch then inched away. ROLLING TIDE sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside and held on well to deep stretch but could not match the winner late. NO APOLOGY was in a good position stalking the pace off the inside to the stretch, came out some in the drive and just held third. ALOKEE broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace outside a rival, came out in the stretch and just missed the show. TOSCANOVA angled in and saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed response in the stretch. DOMINATING HOLIDAY broke a bit slowly, settled inside then just off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn and did not rally. MISS I CARLY also a bit slow to begin, settled three deep then off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace.
