Footnotes

AERIAL MEETING forced the pace between horses much of the way to the second turn, took command and angled in on that bend, responded when challenged in the stretch and held on tenaciously under left handed urging. BOUNTIFUL TABLE prompted the pace three deep, continued outside the winner, challenged alongside that one through a stiff drive and continued willingly but was outgamed. STAR'S MILLENNIUM chased a bit off the rail on the first turn, came out on the backstretch, was a bit wide into the second turn, continued off the inside and bested the others. STETSON LADY bobbled at the start, saved ground, came out approaching the second turn, split rivals midway on that bend but lacked a response in the stretch. TUTA NICHE settled a bit off the rail without early speed, remained just off the inside and was outrun. JUICY PLUM sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace along the rail, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
