**Footnotes**

OLMODAVOR settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, split horses into the stretch and in midstretch, then rallied determinedly under urging while drifting out some late to get up. NOSE THE TRADE (GB) had good early speed three deep then outside a rival on the first turn, inched away on that bend, angled in a bit off the rail on the backstretch, dueled inside, kicked clear nearing the stretch and held on well but was caught late. CHINKAPIN angled in and saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and continued willingly for third. LEGENDARY WEAWE sent inside to duel for the lead, relinquished control on the first turn, came off the rail into the backstretch, bid between foes early on the backstretch then stalked off the inside, came three deep into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and could not offer the necessary late response. TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) pulled hard between horses early then took back on the first turn, went up three deep on the backstretch, dueled outside the runner-up until nearing the stretch and weakened.
