RUMMYSECRET WAR five wide into the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch to take the lead and inched away, turned back the bid of a rival to inch away a bit off the rail again on the second turn, drifted in a bit in the stretch but drew clear under some urging and steady handling. CHANGING (ARG) four wide into the first turn, chased three deep then outside a rival, found the rail in the stretch and gained the place. TURKISH VICTORY pulled his way along off the rail, dueled inside then stalked on the backstretch, bid again inside the winner into the second turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch and just held third. LAINIES LION hopped slightly in a slow start, pulled between horses and was in tight on the first turn, stalked the pace outside then off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and just missed third. BOB BENOIT pulled between horses and was in tight into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and improved position. STREET ROYALE also broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, split rivals into the stretch and was not a threat. JAMES PRIOR saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch, split rivals in the drive and lacked the needed rally. SIDEPOCKET LOU between horses early, stalked off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.

SOLEMN PROMISE four wide into the first turn, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. FASSNACHT pulled his way along four wide early, dueled outside a rival then briefly between foes early on the backstretch, stalked off the rail, angled in on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
