Footnotes

GREAT SIEGE (IRE) settled off the rail then chased between foes, continued inside into and on the second turn, came out for room in midstretch, bid between foes, gained the lead under urging and held on gamely. ART CURRENCY stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, was three deep in midstretch, bid outside foes past the eighth pole then alongside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. RED ALERT DAY (GB) pulled three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival then between foes into and on the second turn, came out in the stretch and edged a rival late for the show. BECRUX (ITY) pulled his way along inside and was in tight into the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and split horses late. MR. ROD had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, kicked clear and angled in on the backstretch, set the pace inside, fought back in deep stretch and weakened late. MUNY also had early speed between foes, dueled a bit off the rail then stalked the pace, was in tight between horses in midstretch and weakened. FIRE BREAK four wide into the first turn, chased three deep then four wide again leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. GLOBAL HEAT pulled between horses and was in a bit tight into the first turn, chased just off the rail, fell back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
