Footnotes

NICE FISH sped to the early lead three deep, angled in when clear, set all the pace and drew off in the stretch under a steady hand ride. EXCESSIVELYCASUAL chased off the rail, moved up outside a rival on the turn and was clearly second best. KAN FLY sent along inside to force the early pace then stalked along the rail, came out leaving the turn and just held third. SILLY LIL off a bit slowly and crowded at the start, settled outside, went alongside a rival into the turn then found the rail, continued inside in the stretch and just missed the show. IMOGENE'S SISTERS between horses early, stalked outside a rival, dropped back on the turn and weakened. GOING NOVA saved ground off the pace, came out some into the stretch and failed to menace. TRACE MY LACE broke slowly and awkwardly, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground and was always outrun.
