Footnotes

SUGAR BABE angled in early, came off the rail on the backstretch, angled four wide into the stretch and closed gamely under left handed urging to get up late. INFINITE FAITH stalked the pace four or three wide throughout, bid into the stretch and outside rivals in midstretch, then continued willingly between foes late. SLIPPERY WHEN BET stalked the pace between horses, steadied in a bit tight on the backstretch, bid between horses again in the stretch, put a head in front late and went gamely to the end. POHAVE sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, shook off a rival on the second turn, fought back a bit off the rail into and through the stretch, regained the fence in deep stretch and was outfinished. CHINOIS unhurried off the rail early, angled in for the second turn, remained inside and made up some ground in the stretch but was not a serious threat. AZILLION (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside in the stretch but lacked room in tight in midstretch, came out and could not recover. PRODUCER squeezed back at the start, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GOLDEN BONUS pulled his way into a bit of a tight spot into the first turn, chased off the rail, angled in on the second turn and weakened. ROYAL RAHY four wide into the first turn, went up to press the pace outside, dropped back between horses on the second turn and gave way.
