BRIECAT sped to the early lead outside a rival, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again in the stretch and proved best under some left handed urging. MODEL settled inside then a bit off the rail, moved up three deep on the second turn and outside a rival into the stretch to loom a threat but could not match the winner late while clearly second best. WAKE UP MAGGIE (IRE) allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. BARONESS THATCHER pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside then a bit off the rail, angled back in entering the stretch and was outfinished for third. DOUBLE TROUBLE (BRZ) chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence leaving the backstretch, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SPENDITALLBABY saved ground off the pace, remained inside in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BAI AND BAI angled in and stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
